Guests can enjoy Hengill volcanic area, Nesjavellir Geothermal Power Station, the river Öxará, Gullfoss waterfall, the hot springs area of Geysir, the Kerið crater and many other natural wonders; just to name a few.

The Northern lights bar offers magnificent panoramic views of Lake Thingvellir and the Northern lights in the winter. Perfect for a evening coffee or a late night cocktail before going to the Lava Spa.

Spa

From the entry way, through naturally adorned treatment areas out onto the stone deck of a lovely 10 meter long hot tub that continually flows like a river.





Summer

Hiking trails

The Hengill area offers most of the features of Iceland's natural beauty; interesting landscapes, geothermal areas with hot springs and craters, diverse vegetation, rivers and lakes.

Diving and snorkeling

The Silfra Frissure is the most popular diving site in Iceland, first of all because it is the crack between the American and Eurasian continent and secondly because of the magnificent visibility that isn't anywhere else under those circumstances. For the most daring divers it is possible to dive through Silfra and into Lake Þingvellir.

Fishing

Þingvellir Lake is one of the most popular fishing spots in Iceland. The Lake is 4 kilometers away from the hotel. The brown trout that lives in the lake can reach incredible sizes. If you are lucky enough to catch an arctic char the chefs will be happy to prepare it for the guests as sashimi or cooked dinner.

Midnight Sun

From 20th of May until the 20th of July, the sun never goes lower than 6° below the horizon – making the skies basically bright all night.

Hot Springs

The Hengill area is in the middle of Iceland's western volcanic belt. Therefore there is a lot of geothermal activity in the area and many hot springs in Nesjavellir.

Glacier tours

Glacial hiking is a all year around activity. Sólheimajökull is the most popular glacier to hike particularly because of the ice wall for the daredevils to climb.

Northern Lights

Nothing is more beautiful than watching the Northern lights in the middle of nowhere with no disturbing sounds or lights. This is exactly what ION Luxury Adventure hotel offers because of it's remote location. The Northern Light is a natural phenomenon that can paint the starbright night sky with surreal colors. Because of Iceland's location the Northern lights are quite frequently noticable over the winter months (August – May). NASA astronomers are predicting that the Northern Lights will be some of the brightest in decades over the next few years due to a peak in the solar cycle, so now is the time to visit.





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
