DAY-TO-DAY SCHEDULE

Day 1: Denpasar - Umabian

Arrival at airport Denpasar and transfer to Umabian, about 1 hour drive from the airport. The hotel is located in a small traditional village surrounded by palmtrees, rice fields and rivers. Overnight in Puri Taman Sari.

Day 2: Umabian

A visit to the royal Taman Ayun temple in Mengwi, a special temple from the 17th century. Also you will visit the famous Tanah Lot Temple, beautifully located on an island in the sea. Overnight at Puri Taman Sari.

Day 3: Umabian – Munduk

The Jatiluwih rice fields belong the UNESCO list of protected areas and are seen as one of the most beautiful rice fields in Indonesia. Here you will make a hike among the rice fields. The tour continues along the mountains and cooler highlands of Bedugul. The route leads to the temple Ulun Danu, located on the Bratan Lake. Probably one of the most photographed spots in Bali. In the afternoon arrival in Munduk. Overnight in Munduk Moding Plantation.

Day 4: Munduk – Lovina Beach

In the hills, surrounded by tropical rain forests and waterfalls, you will find the charming village of Munduk. Accompanied by a guide you will make a 2-hour hike through the area. In the afternoon arrival at Lovina, famous for its black lava beaches and dolphins swimming along the coast. Overnight at The Lovina

Day 5: Lovina – Sidemen

The journey continues through a scenic route along the northern coast and through volcanic areas and small villages. On the way visit of volcano Mt. Batur (1412 m), not the highest volcano in Bali, but the most active. Also you will visit the famous Besakih Temple, also known as the mother of the temples in Bali. Overnight Surya Shanti.



Day 6: Sidemen – Amed

Today you will get to know the rural life of Bali by helping the Balinese farmers. There is the opportunity to participate several workshops such as a traditional cooking workshop. A typical Balinese lunch is served in the village. In the afternoon transfer to Amed, situated at the east coast of Bali on a small strip of fishing villages.

Overnight Jepun Bali Villas

Day 7: Amed – Candidasa

The beaches of Amed are a little gray, but the underwater world is spectacular. This makes Amed a very popular place for divers and snorkelers. In the morning you will make a snorkeling excursion to discover the amazing underwater world. The journey continues along one of the most beautiful roads of Bali. Magnificent views of waterfalls, traditional colorful fishing boats and undiscovered villages. Late afternoon arrival in Candidasa.

Overnight in Alila Manggis

Day 8: Candidasa – Denpasar

In the morning visit to Tenganan, the home village of the Bali Aga people, the original inhabitants of Bali. You can see unique architecture of the village, as well as the traditional basket weaving. Finally, a transfer to the airport of Denpasar or to an accommodation at the south coast of Bali.
